Taking into account the investigations carried out in the file No. 711/P/2012 pending at the Prosecutor's Office attached to the High Court of Cassation and Justice – the Criminal Investigation and Criminalistics Section – checking the observance of the legal provisions regarding the drawing up of the permanent voters' lists as well as the way in which the written documents sent to the Constitutional Court on August 2, 2012 were drawn up, we are hereby specifying that, for the purpose of disposing of this case in compliance with the provisions of Article 97 of the Criminal Procedure Code, on August 3, 2012, in the presence of the Permanent Election Authority, we seized from the company designated to carry out the technical procedures according to Article 43<sup>1</sup> para 5 of the Law No. 3/2000, with the subsequent amendments and completions, **copies of the permanent voters' lists and supplementary voters' lists used in the national Referendum of July 29, 2012 bearing the original signatures of the voters**, as they were handed over to these authorities by the Central Election Bureau.

During the investigations, the Ministry of the Administration and the Interior - the Directorate for Population Records and Management of the Databases – with the Note No. 3456101 of August 8, 2012, sent us **the optical disc containing copies of the permanent voters' lists that, in compliance with the provisions of the Government Decision No. 682 and 683 of July 7, 2012, were printed and placed at the disposal of local public authorities in three copies, by the county / Bucharest municipality structures administering the population records databases, operating under the**

authority of this institution. Through the same above mentioned Note we were also informed that, on August 6, 2012, **the statistics recorded in the National Population Records updated to August 3, 2012** were retrieved from the central registry in order to compare the these data with the ones on the copies of the permanent voters' lists.

Taking into account that, according to the official public releases of the Constitutional Court, the Government was requested to submit the permanent voters' lists updated in compliance with Article 17 para 2 of the Law No. 3/2000 on the organization and running of referendums, we hereby express our availability to place at your disposal **the permanent voters' lists and the supplementary voters' lists used in the Referendum of July 29, 2012 bearing the original signatures of the voters**, as they were handed over to the Central Election Bureau and later seized by the Prosecutor's Office attached to the High Court of Cassation and Justice – the Criminal Investigation and Criminalistics Section, the original documents seized from the Permanent Election Authority and from the company designated to carry out the technical procedures, or certified true copies thereof.

We further specify that all documents were received and kept in compliance with the provisions of the Central Election Bureau concerning the technical operations to be carried out for the centralization of results of the Referendum.

Since all the measures required to carry out the activities provided under Article 43<sup>1</sup> para 5 of the Law No. 3/2000, with the subsequent amendments and completions, were taken, we can place at your disposal the scanned version of the above mentioned documents.
